C., March 1 and 2, 1922 The National Rivers and Harbors Congress was organized at a convention held in Baltimore in October, 1901, following the defeat, through a filibuster, of a River and Harbor Bill in the preceding March. Reorganized at a convention held in Washington, D. C., in January, 1906, it began the nation-wide campaign in favor of the improvement and use of our rivers and harbors which has been continuously carried on until the present day - and which must be carried on until its object, which is of such vital importance to our national interests, has been fully accomplished. Two conventions were held in 1906 (the second one in December), and conventions were held in December of each year thereafter until, and including, 1916. No conventions were held in 1917 or 1918, on account of the war, but two were held in 1919 - in February and December, respectively, followed by one in December, 1920. The Seventeenth Convention would regularly have been held...
