

Mabie spent more than six months of the year 1912-1913 in Japan and Mr. Robert Bacon has recently spent three months in some of the capital cities of South America. During the year 1911-1912 Professor Nitobe, an eminent educator of Japan, spent eight months in the United States, and at the present time Professor Shosuke Sato is visiting a number of American universities and agricultural colleges. Between European countries similar visits are also being carried on, and in the course of one of these Baron d Estourncllcs dc Constant has recently made an important and widely discussed address at Nuremberg.
